

SUMMER BOOK REPORT
For Students Entering 4th Grade
Due Date: First Day of School

Reading:

Each student is to read at least 2 books of his/her choice.
Each book should have at least 90 pages.
Each book should be written by a different author.

Format:

Write your report neatly in cursive with pencil or pen.
Or...
Type your report on the computer.

Page 1:

List the following for each of the 2 books you read over the summer:
Title (remember to underline the titles)
Author
Illustrator (if any)
Publisher
Copyright date
Number of pages

Choose only ONE of your books for the written part of the report.

Page 2:

Summary:

Begin your report by stating the title and the author in the first sentence. Then write one paragraph telling the main ideas of the story. (Don't give away the ending!)

Sample beginning: Because of Winn-Dixie, by Kate DiCamillo, is a story about a girl named Opal and her special friend, a dog named Winn-Dixie.

Opinion:

Write one paragraph to explain your opinion of the story. Would you recommend this book to another student? Tell why or why not.

Finishing:

1. Make one cover with your name, date, and the title of the book you wrote about.
2. Add original art...color it neatly.
3. Staple all sheets together behind the cover.
4. Turn in your report on the first day of school.
